Intranet: Consultations Under Way



The Common Health Intranet Portal project continues to move forward, with a number of individuals dedicating their time and expertise to its completion.

The project team is currently engaged in consultation sessions with key stakeholders from the functional areas that will be serviced in the first release. The data collected will be compiled and used to design and build the first version of each organization's intranet.

The Common Health Intranet Portal will also begin the consolidation process of the existing six zone level intranets. Regional Health Authorities and FacilicorpNB will each have their own intranet, but hosted on a common platform (SharePoint 2010) and leveraging common tools.

Content management, collaboration and several key services are included in the first release.

Phase 1 of the Common Health Intranet Portal will be launched this fall.


First Appearance Before the Standing Committee on Crown Corporations

We recently completed the transition of Clinical Engineering employees to FacilicorpNB, which brought approximately 100 dedicated professionals to our team on April 1st, 2010. This transition was seamless thanks to excellent planning, and great collaboration from the RHAs.

Another critical initiative completed over the past year was the establishment and implementation of key performance indicators that measure our corporate performance and efficiencies. Through the ongoing use of these KPIs, we are in a better position to ensure that we are on

Finally, the development of the Common Health Intranet Portal is progressing very well. After a year full of successes, we are very optimistic about our plans for 2011-2012. Among other things, we expect to continue our work on the laundry file, roll-out the first phase of the intranet, and carry-out the first initiatives towards improving the energy efficiency of our health system.

I look forward to building on our success as we continue towards our goal of making significant improvements to the health system throughout New Brunswick.
